Winner of the 2012 Andrés Montoya Poetry Prize, her first full-length collection, *A Tongue in the Mouth of the Dying*, was selected by Francisco X. Alarcón (University of Notre Dame 2013). Her latest collection, *A Crown for Gumecindo* (Aztlán Libre 2015), a sonnet corona in memory of her grandfather, received the 2016 Helen C. Smith Award for poetry from the Texas Institute of Letters. She served as the 2016 Texas Poet Laureate.
